#### Patrilineal Descent Groups

#### How Family Is Defined

Family viewed in terms of relationship via childbirth and/or marriage. Individual regards as family those living persons who are related to her or him within an arbitrary limit of time (a few generations up or down) and extent (cousins usually included).

Family viewed in terms of consanguinity—sharing the blood of a common ancestor. Individual regards as family all persons—living or deceased—with whom he or she shares a common male ancestor. Only males can pass family blood on to next generation.

#### MARRIAGE

Marriage is understood relationally. A good marriage is one that proves mutually satisfying to the two individuals involved.

Marriage is understood contractually. A good marriage is one that enhances the honor of the extended family system.

#### Women

A daughter is free to marry as she wishes. She and her spouse together establish a new nuclear family unit. She views herself—and is viewed by others—as a member of her new family.

A daughter is married out of her own kinship group into a family to which she can never truly belong. Her primary role is to bear a son to provide for the survival of her husband's patriline.

#### RESIDENCE

Persons who marry are expected to leave their parents' home to set up their own (neolocal) residence. Family is a consuming unit but typically does not share together in a corporate economic enterprise. Members of the patrilineal descent group live together (patrilocal residence): father, sons, and unmarried daughters—along with the father's wife and the wives of his sons. The kinship group is typically a producing and consuming unit.

#### KEY RELATIONSHIPS


Tightest units of loyalty, affection, and emotional intimacy are husband-wife and parent-child relationships. Sibling relations are not expected to exhibit this degree of affection and emotional intimacy. Relational failure is epitomized in the dissolution of a marriage.

Tightest unit of loyalty and affection is the descent group of brothers and sisters. The emotional bonding characteristic of marriage in Western families is normally a mark of sibling (or mother-son) relationships in the PKG. Relational failure is epitomized in the betrayal of a sibling.

#### Ancestors and Inheritance

Little concern for ancestral origins. No convictions that one's value as an individual is contingent upon the honor or achievements of one's ancestor(s). Inheritance understood individually: each child is entitled to his or her share.

Passionate preoccupation with ancestral origins. Personal honor is strongly dependent on one's ancestral lineage. Inheritance understood collectively—it belongs to the patriline as a whole and must be preserved as such.
